Edukite Competition 2023

Cape Mental Health will be hosting a number of activities in October to celebrate Mental Health Awareness Month. We invite teams of learners from mainstream primary schools and schools for learners with special educational needs to participate.

The Edukite Competition prize-giving and fun fly will take place at the Zandvlei Lookout on Promenade Road in Muizenberg on Saturday 21 October 2022 from 10:00 to 13:30.

Prizes

A panel of judges will judge the decorated kites. Prizes will be awarded to the winning school teams in two groups: (1) Learners with special educational needs and (2) learners from mainstream primary schools.

1st Prize – R3 000
2nd Prize – R2 000

3rd Prize – R1 000
4th Prize – R500

What should we do to enter?

- Register a team of 4 LEARNERS for the competition by filling in the form overleaf and sending it to events@cmh.org.za by **Friday 06 October**.
- Once we have confirmed your registration, we will deliver **4 kite kits** to your school **at no cost**. The kits will have all the materials and instructions the learners need to make the kites.
- Learners decorate the kite skins showing their understanding of the theme "**The Sky is Your Canvas**" and what this means for their mental health.
- Take a **team photo** of the four learners each holding their decorated kites and **send the photo** to events@cmh.org.za. We do not need the names of participating learners.

Fun Fly & Prize-Giving Programme

- There is **no fee** to enter the competition.
- Competition participants will have to be at Zandvlei Lookout by 09:30 on Saturday 21 October.
- An educator and or parent must accompany all learners to the Fun Fly and prize giving.
- Participating teams have to bring their decorated kits to the venue for display in the clubhouse.
- The children will enjoy a programme of kite flying, fun and learning from 10:30 to 11:30 during which time the panel of judges will judge the kite entries.
- The prize giving will take place at 12:00. Winning teams will have the opportunity to present their entries to the audience and the team or a single spokesperson can speak about their understanding of "The Sky is Your Canvas" and what this means for mental health.
- We will provide light refreshments to participating teams but children with particular dietary needs must please bring their own snacks.

Please note

- Schools invited to the fun fly and prize giving on 21 October at the Zandvlei Lookout will receive wristbands for 4 learners and 2 adults (educators and or parents) per school for free entry and refreshments.
- Other people accompanying the learners will be asked to donate R10 per adult and R5 per child to gain admission.
